The 2018 Tang Prize in Sustainable Development.

It is our honor to invite you to nominate scholars you deem most deserving of this Prize, according to the following criteria: *The Tang Prize in Sustainable Development recognizes those who have made extraordinary contributions to the sustainable development of human societies, especially through groundbreaking innovations in science and technology.* The ideal candidate would be of a caliber deserving the most distinguished awards in the world. This Prize will grant a cash award of NT\$40 million (around US\$1.36 million), plus a NT\$10 million grant (around US\$341,000) for further endeavors. Up to three laureates can share this award.

The Tang Prize was founded in 2012 with a simple mission: to biennially recognize and support groundbreaking research and developments of significance to humanity, in four major categories: *Sustainable Development, Biopharmaceutical Science, Sinology, and Rule of Law.* A separate selection committee is responsible for each award category and consists of approximately twenty world-leading experts to select the most deserving laureate(s).
