It is our honor to invite you to nominate scholars you deem most deserving of this Prize, according to the following criteria: The Tang Prize in Sustainable Development recognizes those who have made extraordinary contributions to the sustainable development of human societies, especially through groundbreaking innovations in science and technology. The ideal candidate would be of a caliber deserving the most distinguished awards in the world. This Prize will grant a cash award of NT\$40 million (around US\$1.36 million), plus a NT\$10 million grant (around US\$341,000) for further endeavors. Up to three laureates can share this award.

The Tang Prize was founded in 2012 with a simple mission: to biennially recognize and support groundbreaking research and developments of significance to humanity, in four major categories: Sustainable Development, Biopharmaceutical Science, Sinology, and Rule of Law. A separate selection committee is responsible for each award category and consists of approximately twenty world-leading experts to select the most deserving laureate(s).
